### THEY WORE THE SHIRT: STEFAN NIELSEN

THE ICONIC IMAGE OF THE TWO STEFANS. Kilron and Nielsen, celebrating the latter's goal against Wanderers in our first ever home game, is probably the most famous in our history. It went viral, immediately creating an international demand for our away shirt - shaping the future of the club.

Stefan a cultured midfielder made a major contribution in our debut season, both as a goal scorer and provider of assists. The creative part of his game is exemplified by him providing assists in half of the games he played. Of the 97 goals scored that season Stefan provided 17 assists, including three in the 6-1 league defeat of Wilberforce Wanderers. Arguably his most influential game came at South Kilburn Reserves in the Jim Rogers Cup. In a POTM winning performance Stefan scored twice and provided an assist for Dean Bouho's goal, in a 4-2 win.

Only Dean Bouho, and Eliot Crosbie made more overall appearances than Stefan in that successful first season. He missed only one of the last 16 games, of which only two were lost, as the team won the league and contested two cup finals, winning one.

Stefan would only make a further three appearances the following season, as he relocated to Oxford, his last contribution a goal in his last cup game at Hillingdon in The Alec Smith Cup.
