THROUGHOUT FEBRUARY WE ARE BACKING the Football v Homophobia (FvH) campaign.

Collectively, we want to demonstrate that football should be for everyone and through football we can break down the artificial barriers that exist in our community.

All seven of our teams have designated a game or training session, including the Women's First Team cup game against Ashford United last week and today's Men's First Team game:

- Our captains will wear rainbow armbands and our players rainbow laces to raise awareness
- We holding a bucket shake and selling limited edition badges in aid of two LGBTQ+ campaigns, Come As You Are and Lesbians & Gays Support The Migrants
- Buy a guest beer from **Queer Brewing in** Leyton, a gueer and trans-owned brewery. They will donate 10p from every beer to a LGBTQ+ charity





MY EXPERIENCE OF LGBTQ+ PEOPLE IN FOOTBALL – CHARLIE FAGAN

I'VE PLAYED MEN'S FOOTBALL FOR 18 YEARS. FOR SUNDAY teams on Hackney Marshes, midweek games on Market Road's cambered pitches, university mud baths in Manchester and five seasons with CCFC's men's team. Across hundreds of teammates, I have never shared a changing room with anyone who was openly LGBTQ+.

Statistically, this is almost impossible. It was recently reported that one-in-ten 16 to 24-yearolds identify as lesbian,

gay or bisexual, so if my changing rooms were even remotely representative, I would have had loads of LGBTQ+ teammates.

Our first competitive game for more than four months due to Covid is played behind closed doors due to ongoing restrictions. Scorer: Noah Adejokun.

The fact that I haven't, or haven't been aware of them, means either they deemed football an unsafe space and did not play, or they were there and didn't feel able to be open about their sexuality. Either way, <u>football failed them</u>, meaning my experience of LGBTQ+ people in football is sadly one of absence.

My experience is typical across the men's game. Blackpool's Jake Daniels is the only openly gay male professional footballer in England. With 5,000+ male professionals in England, it is a terrible indictment of men's football that no other LGBTQ+ players have felt able to come out and demonstrates the importance of being loud and visible in supporting campaigns like Football v Homophobia.

While women's football has celebrated recent high profile on-field successes, it also <u>provides a model</u> for LGBTQ+ inclusivity that men's football must learn from to boost representation and visibility, from grassroots to the professional game.

Having never had an openly LGBTQ+ player in CCFC M1T, we can do more to ensure LGBTQ+ players know they are welcome and ensure the club's values are represented on the pitch as well as in the Scaffold.

I want to play in a sport where <u>everyone feels</u> <u>welcome</u> and <u>valued</u>, and <u>proudly support</u> Football v Homophobia.
